The Clinton Hill CSA is in its last weeks, and we invite you to have first dibs at joining for the 2010 season. Your commitment and support brings fresh, locally-grown, organic vegetables to our neighborhood. Last year our membership filled quickly. To make sure you have a 2010 share, please send in your \$25 non-refundable deposit along with the bottom of this letter as soon as possible. This deposit reserves your vegetable share; in April, you will receive an agreement form and can pay the rest of your share balance as well as sign up for fruit, flower and egg shares. We aim to keep the same ratio of Plan A and Plan B members as we have in the past so please check the box at the bottom that fits your family.

#### YOUR CSA SHARE

Once again the season will last 22 weeks - from Mid-June to Mid-November. Based on farm expenses, share prices will increase slightly for next season, though we don't have exact figures. 2009 share prices were:

Plan A: Families with a total income of over \$30,000 pay \$495 (\$22.50 a week)

Plan B: Families with a total income under \$30,000 pay \$315(\$14.32 a week)

Our limited membership slots fill quickly, so sign up now. Check should be made payable to "Windflower Farm."
